We will be becoming expert Geographers and learning all about our wonderful village, Singleton.

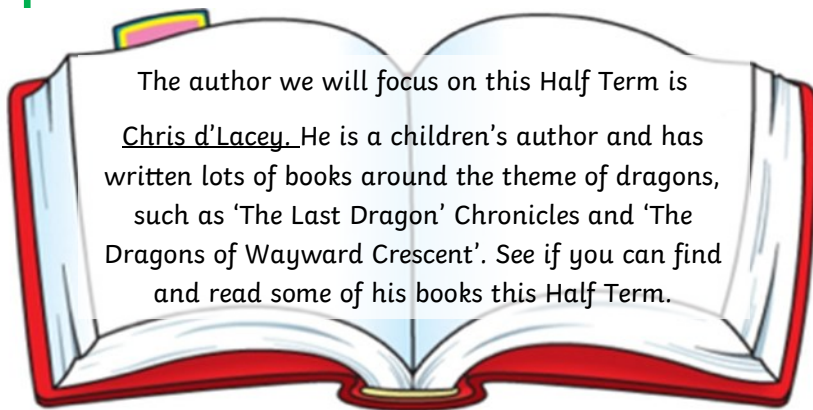
We will have the opportunity to practise lots of important Geographical skills as we study our village, including map work, field sketching, data collection and much more.
