Text has been edited to improve content and correct spelling.

Use of modal verbs to explain possibility.

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You have disappointed me! What have I ever done you? Why, Why! You making crazy mad that you make me think that you are a lawbreaker (criminal). I was wrong to let you survive and I should have never trusted you. WHY DID You LET HER PROCEED!

Use of brackets for parenthesis.

Your enemy/worst night mare, the Ice Witch.

TRANSCRIPTION

Spelling is mostly accurate with occasional errors - spys, intelagent, insted
