Parents FAQ's

What do my children need to bring?

We provide you with a full kit list so stick to that and they'll be well catered for

Should my child bring money with them?

They can bring up to £5 as we may go to Bosham and get an ice-cream/snack. We've no vending machines on site and they'll not otherwise have an opportunity to spend

Can they bring their own tuck?

We don't recommend it, we endeavour to provide healthy, nutritious and filling meals.

Can they bring their phone?

No, we don't recommend any electrical devices are bought with them. If they do we will collect them and keep them in their safe for them. You are welcome to phone the office and emergency numbers are provided.

What food requirements are catered for?

You will be asked to provide any specific dietary requirements in advance and our cook is wonderful at providing a variety of food for all needs.

What's the schedule?

Days will normally start with breakfast at 8am, activities from 9.30am till 4.30 (with fifteen minute break morning and afternoon and lunch for one hour). Tea is served at around 5.30

What happens in the evenings?

We offer sessions from 7pm till 8.30 but if your school has not taken this option this time will be led by the teachers in games, walks and other activities

How many share a room/tent?

For Jubilee and Log cabin dorm rooms vary from 4 to 8. Bell tents are also generally six per tent, (the tents can sleep up to 10 so are spacious for six).

Depending on your booking you'll need to bring duvet and pillow, if you're camping then a roll mat or airbed will also be needed. Space isn't plentiful so all kit should fit into a rucksack or kit bag

What happens if it rains?

We provide wetsuits for the water based but we recommend you bring waterproofs. If there is thunder and lightning outdoor activities will be curtailed.
