
Beside the Seaside

English

In our English, we are starting our writing journey using 'Until I Met Dudley' by Roger McGough and Chris Riddell. This book will be used to teach the children how to write formal and informal explanatory texts. The book teaches the children how a range of objects work including toasters and washing machines.



Guided Reading

For Guided Reading, we will be using a gorgeous book called 'Skygazing' by Anna Claybourne.
Skygazing teaches all about the sky at both daytime and night time including stars, clouds and birds.





Maths

We begin our maths learning about place value which includes how to represent, compare and order numbers. We will also begin looking at our times tables begin to practice and increase our fluency in recalling the times tables. This would be a good topic to practice at home with your child in the evenings or mornings. Just challenging them to answer some questions will build their fluency and confidence.

<u>Flourish</u>

Together, Beech Team will be creating a beachside café for their flourish this half term. During our beach trip, we will be exploring a range of restaurants and cafés near East Wittering Beach. After reviewing the local cuisine, Beech will then create their own café serving a range of savoury and sweet options to the other classes of Singleton Primary School.
