Reorganising Parents Meetings

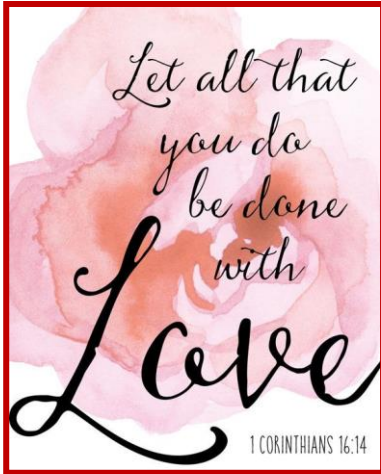
