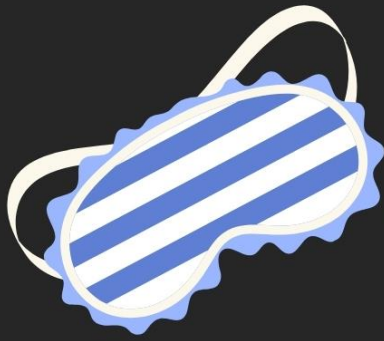
## Golden Book
