Value of FRIENDSHIP

Bible Passage 1 Thessalonians 5.11

This week's worship focused on building others up through encouragement and support. The children created a "Tower of Encouragement" for Miss Spencer, with each kind word or phrase adding a brick to the tower, symbolising how positive words help confidence grow. One final brick, filled with unkind comments, caused the tower to topple, leading to a discussion about how hurtful words and actions can be. We encouraged the children to look for opportunities this week to build each other up rather than knock others down, reminding them that mean words and rude behaviour say everything about the person using them, and nothing about the person being targeted.
