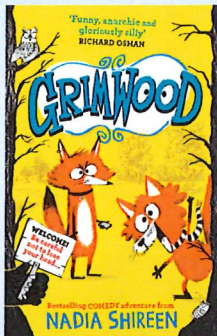


Bright Lights, Big City

In Guided Reading, Year 2 will be looking at the book:

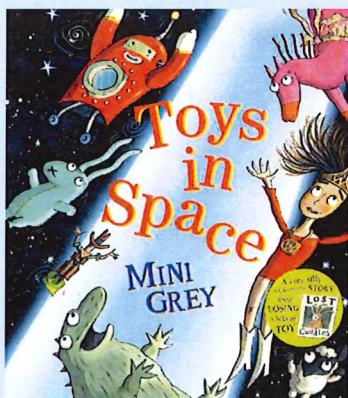


In Year 1 and Year R, we will be sharing a variety of books which are linked to our topic.
