- Time

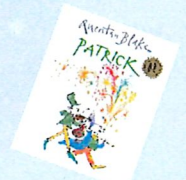
Religious Education

Author Study

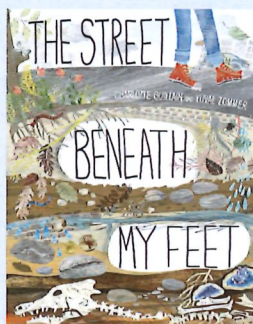
Our author of the half term is: **Quentin Blake**
