

IT'S ALL GREEK TO ME



This half term, Oak class are travelling back in time to Ancient Greece! In Design and Technology, we are focusing on food tech and will be learning all about Ancient Greek cuisine. We will look at certain cooking skills like following recipes, and using electrical cooking equipment before putting on our own Greek feast! In History, we will be learning what the Greeks did for us, and the origins of the Olympics! We will look at the geographical location of Greece, using an atlas.

Author Study

This half-term we will be looking at Katherine Rundell. She is a celebrated British author known for her adventurous, imaginative children's books. Her stories often feature brave young characters, wild landscapes, and themes of friendship, resilience, and discovery. Inspired by her own love of nature and exploration

Flourish

As our main focus this half term is Design and Technology, Oak class will be putting on their own Greek Feast as their flourish task. They will be using cooking skills as well as their knowledge of ancient Greek food to put their stalls together. Alongside their food, Oak class will be displaying some key knowledge learnt through our history and geography lessons.

Maths

This half-term we will be looking at Decimals, Fractions and percentages, as well as shape.

English

We will be looking at personal opinion and advising others in our writing this half term, studying 'Robot Girl' by Malorie Blackman. This story is based on robots that will take over all jobs in the community, which the children will go on to discuss and debate

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Science

This half term, children will use their knowledge of height, strength and weight to determine if they have a significant impact on performance. Children will use various experiments to conduct a fair test in our lessons.

French

This half term we will be looking at Les Jeux Olympiques! Children will make links across their learning to learn about the history of the Olympic Games in French!

PSHE

This half term, we will be looking at citizenship, the role of the justice system and influential people in our community.

Children will discuss the rights and responsibilities that we are entitled to.

Guided Reading.

This half term, children will be studying the book "Who Let The Gods Out?" By Maz Evans. Children will use prediction inferences and draw conclusions based on their reading.
